This entry level Cargo New Fabricator position is responsible for the accurate alignment of webbing by using the template on the tables as a guideline. The guides show the webbing measurement and dimensions. This position will handle hardware and ultrasonic welders.

- Work with supervisor towards meeting performance standards. – Daily
